### **ANNUAL ACTIVITY REPORT FOR APRIL 2016 –MARCH 2017**

#### **Introduction:**

Rural Workers Development Society was founded in the year 2007 by a group of public minded leaders those who are effectively concerning in community development activities for more than three decades. It was registered under Tamilnadu Societies Registration Act vide Registration number 93/2007. Its head quarters are located in Ramanathapuram. RWDS is working among children, women, youth, farmers, rural unorganized workers especially Palmyrah Workers in Ramnad District.

**State** : Tamilnadu

**District** : Ramanathapuram.

**Blocks** : Kadalady, Tirupullani, Mandapam .

**Vision** :The socio economic development of the marginalized with emphasis on Palmyrah Workers, Women and Children

#### **Mission:**

- To mobilize and federate the Palmyrah workers irrespective of caste, creed or religion to organize for their livelihood issues.
- To make them understand their condition and motivate them to participate in their development through awareness generation.

- To improve their bargaining power and to link with Govt and formal institutions for self reliance and substances.
- To enable for adequate health and education to Children for better tomorrow.

### **Working Areas:**

Ramanathapuram is situated along the Eastern coastal District of the Southern Tamilnad. The Bay of Bengal in the east, The Gulf of Manner in the whole sea shore, Sivagangai, Pudukottai, Virudhunagar, and Tuticorin constitute its boundaries. Spreading over an area of 4232 sq'km. This District is divided into 11 development Blocks and it has the highest population of urban population among the major districts. The incidence of poverty and drought is highest among the 32 districts. Ramnad has also a population of scheduled castes 28% children compose 27.2% of the population.

Project operational area is located in Ramanathapuram District in Southern part of Tamil Nadu (650 Km away from Chennai). Drinking water is acute problem. Women have to walk miles together to fetch water, and it is very difficult to get pure, soft and potable water irrespective of Government efforts. In brief Ramanathapuram is a most backward and underdeveloped district in terms of Socio-Economic and industrial development

## ACTIVITIES

### 1. CLC (Child Labor Committee) MEETING

Prevention of child labor and mainstreaming them to education is one of our main objectives. We had identified 318 child labors among 4821 in our 52 target villages. Among them 70% of the child labors are in Kadaladi block. We had mobilized them

as Child Labor Committee. The CLC has been actively functioning in 9 villages of Kadaladi block. In this committee they meet every week and enjoy the childhood. We had facilitated them to reenroll in schools and other technical institutions as the child wish. For this year we had conducted 65 meetings in which 139 boys and 179 girls were took part and benefited.

In this meetings plastic wire basket making training given as alternative livelihood to 15 child labours from N.Kamarajapuram, Periyamayakipuram, PP Kudiyeruppu, Manickanagar and M.Gandhinagar villages.

## **2. CHILD LABOUR INDIVIDUAL SKILL DEVELOPMENT TRAINING**

Child labour Individual skill development training conducted on 09-10-2016 and 10-10-2016 at TRRM training centre in Pamban. 6 Boys and 13 girl children took participatipate in this training. Mr.Christi (Advocacy Coordinator – Samakalvi Iyakkam) lead about Group activities, Leadership & Capacity building, individual development trainings. All of the participators learned, how to lead our works and activities with planning.



### **3. CHILD LABOR PARENTS COMMITTEE**

We do number of activities to eradicate the child labor practice. To boost the activity we had decided to promote Parents Committee of Child Labor in our target villages. The committee can help us to generate more rapport with parents and give parents more understandings about the evils of child labor.

During this year we had promoted Child Labor Parents Committee in 1.Keezhavalasai 2.Kannikapuri, 3.N.Kamarajapuram, 4.Mayakulam, 5.Selvanayakipuram, 6.Keezha Allikulam, 7.Elanthaikulam, 8.Vellapatti, 9.Kuthiraimozhi Pandianagar villages. We had conduct meeting of this committee ones in two months and discussed about the demerits of child labor practice. We had insisted about importance of child hood and education. 326 parents participated in all of these meetings.

### **4. ANTI CHILD LABOUR DAY – RALLY – SEMINAR**

Anti Child labour day seminar conducted on 14-06-2016 in community hall at Sayalkudi. Child labours, their Parents, Palmyrah workers, Panchayat Presedents, Police, Child line and Public were took participate (about 87 persons) in this Seminar and Rally.

Mr.Sathaiah,, Director – RWDS headed to this Seminar. Mrs.Rajalakshmi kannappan came as special guest. Mr.Rajasingam , Sub Inspector of Police – Sayalkudi started the Anti Child labor day Rally. It started from Sayalkudi and ended at Mookaiyoor Road via markets.



## **5. CONSULTATION MEETING WITH CHILD LABOUR**

Consultation meeting about Child labor conducted on 22-09-2016 at Elementary Teachers Association hall in Ramanathapuram. In this meeting Mr.G.Vishwanathan, Deputy Inspector of Labor Welfare board, Mr.Maheswaran- Social Worker, Child protection unit, Ramanathapuram, Mr.S.Karuppasamy – Child Line - Ramanathapuram. were the special guest for that meeting. They insisted to parents, for they would enrolled their children below 14 years to nearby schools at worksite areas.



## **6. RESOLUTIONS AT GRAMA SABHA**

We facilitated the Palmyrah Sangam members and village volunteers to participate in the Gramasabha meetings held on 1<sup>st</sup> May 2015, 15<sup>th</sup> August 2015, 2<sup>nd</sup> October 2015 and 26<sup>th</sup> January 2016.

(4) VellariOodai Panchayat – All children continued their education up to their 18 years. school dropout free Panchayat, child marriage free Panchayat and form the child protection group.

5). Anganwadi building for Periyayakipuram, N.Kamarajapuram> Manickanagar and Veppamarathupanai . New Govt Primary school for Periyayakipuram village. Activate the child protection committee in every month. school dropout free Panchyat, child marriage free Panchyat.

## **8. MEDICAL CAMP FOR CHILD LABORS**

The child labors working in salt pane company is working in high heat and unhygienic place. They are suffering from skin disease and urinal problems. The child labor working in sea Food Company is working in high cold place and not wearing gloves. They also affected by skin disease, low hp and urinal and menstrual problems.

We plan to monitor the health of the child labor of Salt Pane Company and Sea Food Company. For this purpose we did health checkup for ones in two months. In this health checkup 42 child labors from Periyayakipuram, Manickanagar, Kamarajapuram, Vellapatti, Velayuthapuram, Kuthiraimozhil Panidanagar, Elanthaikulam and Boopandiapuram villages were benefited. After the Medical check up the affected children referred to take nutrient food, Iron taplets and drink more water to daily.



### **9.CHILDREN COLLECTIVE MEETINGS :**

Children age between 6 and 18 in the target villages has organized as a committee to develop their social education and practice the right to participation. Every children age between 6 and 18 are the members of these collectives. The collective meets every week to discuss and share about their wishes. We had given training on leadership, RTE, and comics drawing. The collectives are connected as cluster level as Koravalli, Kilakarai, Uchipulli, Tirupullani, Naripaiyur and Kavakulam.

Children day was celebrated in Nathakulam, Kavakulam, Kumbaram and Alaivaikaraivadi, people participated including Children Committee members, Palmyra Sangam Members, Parents, Panchayat Members and Public.



## **12. 100% SCHOOL ENTROLEMENT CAMPAIGN**

School enrolment campaign to ensure 100% enrolment in our target villages had conducted during this year also in 52 villages. In our 52 working villages enrolment campaign conducted for Anganwadi to 3 years children and 5 years children in school. Entrolment Campaign conducted through Cycle Rally, Cultural Programes, Provide Bit notices and conduct Seminars also. Children collectives members, Palmyrah sangam members, Panchayat level elected members, Anganwadi staff and public like 1060 members took participated in this Campaign.



## **13.A STUDY ON THE STATUS OF CHILDREN IN THE MIGRANT FAMILIES OF PALMYRA WORKERS IN RAMNAD**

A detailed study on Migrated Families and Children in Kadaladi Block, Ramanathapuram district was conducted. As per our plan we had had a details study about the migrated families who is engaged in Palmyrah tapping in 11 palmyrah groves – 1.Periyanyakipuram, 2.Chathiram, 3.Kannikapuri Sevalkadu, 4.Ellaipinchai, 5.Kadugusanthai, 6.Kannirajapuram Sevelkadu, 7.Tharaikudi, 8.Boopandiapuram Sevelkadu, 9.Kumbasalai, 10.Kilaallikulam, 11.Kuthiraimozhi Sevalkadu . Study conducted in 553 families in all these 11 villages.

Palmyrah workers living in migrated area who havn't proper medical facilities, so RWDS arranged a consultmeeting with joint Director – Health Department, on 24-06-2016 for arranging the mobile Hospital sent to their working areas.

For continuous this process on 30-06-2016 arranged the consulting meeting at Sayalkudi Govt Primary Health Centre. Dr.Sivaramapandiyan headed this meeting. Planning about

Mobile Hospital services provide to Pregnant women, Lactating mothers and Children, and old citizens in to their working and resistant area.



Impact of this meeting 32 persons benefited through this mobile hospital in Ellaipinchai, Kadukusanthai, Kudhiraimozhi Pandiyanagar, Poopandiyapuram and several kadu villages.

On 23-11-2016 conducted a meeting with Programme Officer – ICDS for admit the 3-5 year children who are in Migrated Palmyrah workers family. And arranged the meeting with District Educational officer – Paramakudi for unavailability of neighboring school for children who are in Migrated Palmyrah workers family. And also met Chief Educational officer and District Coordinator – Sarva Siksh Abiyan for submit the Report on admit the migrated palmyrah workers children in neighboring school in their migrated and working area.

#### **14. HOUSEHOLD MEETING IN MIGRATED PLACES**

One to one household approach is to generate more rapport with parents and create a awareness about Child drop out, Child labor practice and child marriage in target villages. By this strategy we can promote a live relationship with every family. We can have more understanding about the children and their needs. In this regard our team had visited all the 2417 target families every months.



## **15. MEETING WITH SCHOOL HM & TEACHERS:**

Children of migrant families are different from other children. They are live in a different situation where no basic facilities like water, electricity, transport and hospital. So, we could treat the children in different way and positively understand their late coming, unfinished homeworks, and irregularity in attendees. To make aware the school HM and Teachers we had special meetings with them. During this year we had met HM and Teachers in schools of Govt higher secondary school – Sikkal, Govt higher secondary school – Mariyoor, Kadaladi Panchayat Union Middle School – Poopandiyapuram, Govt higher secondary school – Kannirajapuram,

## **16. SCHOOL MANAGEMENT COMMITTEE**

Education is the basic right, we know. To practice the basic right, RTE 2009 gives a wonderful opportunity to parents to act positively in promoting their school. School Management Committee (SMC) is the opportunity to the parents of all villages. After the implementation of the RTE 2009, the Government had taken no proper steps to activate the SMC in appropriate way. The education officials including HM and Teachers also give no importance to SMC. They treat just like a burden. No, school had have School Development Plan meeting is SMC in our target villages, which gives space to parents to input their ideas and wishes. So generate awareness on SMC to parents we could reach proper implementation of RTE 2009.

SMC training conducted at Adencheri, Alaikathavalasai, laksh mipuram, Manickanagar and Vellapatti. Mr.C.J.Rajan, Samam Kudimakkal Iyakkam, Madurai, had facilitated the training. He explained how the SMC system is promoted by the RTE 2009 act. He also detailed about

the roles and responsibilities of the SMC committee and how many members and whom to be a member. The participants decided to take action regarding upgrade the Primary School.

## **17. SCHOOL MANAGEMENT COMMITTEEREFRESH TRAINING**

Training of last year for the parents in Kannigapuri, Melakidaram, Vellapatti, Keezhallikulam and Poopandiyapuram villages, in continuous of this refresh training held on 24-09-2016 at Sayalkudi. Mr.C.J.Rajan, Samam Kudimakkal Iyakkam, Madurai, had facilitated the training. He explained how the SMC system is promoted by the RTE 2009 act. He also detailed about the roles and responsibilities of the SMC committee and how many members and whom to be a member. The participants decided to take action regarding upgrade the Primary School.



## **18. NEW PRIMARY SCHOOL**

New primary school to Sengalaneerodai and Periyayakipuram village is an important need. Sengalaneerodai village is situated in Kanchirankudi Panchayat and 6km far from Kilakarai town. The village had 250 population and 52 children, age 3 – 5, but, here is no school. The children have to walk for 12km up and down even primary education. This situation is increasing school dropouts in primary school also.

Periyayakipuram, Rayappapuram and Kamarajapuram villages has 600 population including 143 children age 3 – 5. These villages are in Naripaioor panchayat, Kadaladi Taluk. These villages have situated other side of Kanniyakumari to Rameswaram ECR road while the Primary school is in next side of that road. Children have to walk for 6km up and down; also crossing the ECR road is being dangerous.

In this regard education task force committee for new primary school to Sengalaneerodai and Periyayakipuram had taken number of steps. Last year, Sengalaneerodai villagers had filed case in Madras high court of Madurai bench on New Primary School and got an order insisted the Government to provide primary school within 8weeks. During this reporting period both the villagers had met with the Registrar of Madras High Court of Madurai bench and submitted memorandum about the

### **19. FOLLOW UP ACTIONS FOR ACTIVATE THE ICDS**

We are working for the pre – primary education of children between 3 – 5 years in our target villages. Among 52 target village 36 ICDS are functioning while other 10 villages had no ICDS in the village, the children have to go for other village and infrastructure and functioning of the ICDS is more pathetic. To ensure the proper pre-primary education to our target children we had campaign regarding its function, infrastructure and staff appointments.

- Ammapattinam people Posted a Banner that we neglect the Election till we get the New anganwadi to our village. This news published in all medias and Noticed in to Govt Autharities.

### **20.MEDIA CAMPAIGN**

To highlight the issue of migrant children and child labor in Palmyrah Worker family we had a media campaign on 29-07-2016 by Pudiathalaimurai TV. The Video Shoot regarding Media Campaign was happened and focused that children residing with their parents at Chathiram and Kadukuchanthai area in which Palmyrah tappers.

### **21. PHC LEVEL HEALTH CONVERGENZE MEETING**

To ensure the health of our target people, we had health committees in the villages. The committees have a register about ANC, PNC, Adolescents and children aged

between 0 – 5. They had facilitated the VHN to get health service to their villagers. In this regard, we had organized PHC level health convergence meetings to create a rapport among the Medical Doctors, VHN, Health workers of PHC and health committees. The resource persons were explained about the services, infrastructures and Government schemes available in the PHCs. ANC, PNC, Adolescent girls and Village Health Committee representatives were being active in the meeting. During this reporting period 9 meetings were organized at Sayalkudi, Thiru Uthirakosamanga, and Uchipulli.

Rs.1,06,500 as maternity aid from Government of Tamilnadu under Dr.Muthulaxmi Reddy scheme and Janani Sureksha Scheme for PNCs in our target villages.




## **22. DISTRICT LEVEL CHILD PROTECTION UNIT**

### **24. PALMYRAH SANGAM CLUSTER MEETINGS:**

To attain development of the Palmyrah workers and their children we formed Palmyra Workers as Panai Thozhilalar Sangam. The Sangam has its function as village level, Cluster level and District level. Every level there is a governing body consists of 1 President, 1 vice president, 1 Secretary, 1 Joint secretary and 1 Treasurer. The village Sangam meets every month and the Cluster Sangam meets once in two months and the District level committee meets yearly once.
